A PROCLAMATION

IN the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. Amen.

TO the Faithful in Jesus Christ throughout the World,

GREETINGS:

WHEREAS the College of Bishops of the Traditional Anglican Communion in plenary session held in Calgary, Alberta, Canada, on June 6, 2019, unanimously adopted the Constitution of the Traditional Anglican Church to replace the existing Concordat of the Traditional Anglican Communion; and did thereby reconstitute the Traditional Anglican Communion as a global Church within the historic Anglican tradition of Christ's one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church;

AND WHEREAS the General Synods or highest governing bodies of the national Churches and Provinces of the Traditional Anglican Communion in 2019 and 2020 did subsequently ratify the Constitution of the Traditional Anglican Church adopted by the College of Bishops;

AND WHEREAS the Concordat of the Traditional Anglican Communion provides that upon the ratification by the national Churches and Provinces, the changes adopted by the College of Bishops shall take effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, WE the Most Reverend Shane B. Janzen, Primate of the Traditional Anglican Communion, by and with the advice and consent of the College of Bishops, and with the ratification of the national Churches and Provinces as aforesaid in accordance with the provisions of the Concordat of the Traditional Anglican Communion, do hereby Proclaim the adoption and ratification of the CONSTITUTION OF THE TRADITIONAL ANGLICAN CHURCH, and declare the same to be of full force and effect as of the date of this Proclamation.

AND WE DO HEREBY require that all Our beloved brethren and all others whom these Presents may concern do take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

GIVEN under Our Hand and Seal at Our Cathedral Church of Saint John the Evangelist, Victoria, British Columbia, Canada this twenty-third day of March, in the year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty and of Our Primacy the Fourth.
